

AFHTO 2014 WORKSHOPS- GOVERNANCE AND LEADERSHIP PROGRAM: Frequently Asked Questions

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Dates and Locations

1. When and where do the workshops take place?

The workshops will be held on the following dates and locations:

- Holiday Inn & Suites Ottawa Downtown Ottawa on Wednesday, March 5, 2014
- Best Western Primrose Hotel -Toronto on Monday, March 24, 2014
- Best Western Plus Nor'Wester Hotel & Conference Centre Thunder Bay on Monday, March 31, 2014

2. How long does a workshop last?

Each workshop is a one-day session from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. with breaks for lunch and refreshment.

3. I'm unable to attend on the dates mentioned above. Will any more workshops be held this year? We intend to offer this program on a periodic basis. These current workshops are funded by the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care. While AFHTO will be proposing arrangements for on-going Ministry support for this program, future funding of the program may require other sources of funding and participant registration fees to be put in place. AFHTO will announce new sessions as soon as we are able to do so.

4. How do I register for a workshop?

5. What are the workshop registration fees?

The Ministry has funded AFHTO to organize and deliver the *Effective Governance for Quality in Primary Care* program and as such we are pleased to be able to offer it to our members **at no charge**. Attendees are responsible for all other costs incurred in order to come to a workshop, such as travel and accommodation. Group discount codes for accommodation at each venue are available. Please see 'Accommodation and Directions' for further details.

6. Who should register for a workshop?

Board Members, Executive Directors and Clinical Leads of all AFHTO member organizations are invited to attend; however, there is a limit of 3 representatives from each organization to increase the space available to all members.

7. We've already participated in a workshop last year; can I still send other representatives?

We understand that the leadership team within FHTs and NPLCs change on a regular basis. If your organization has already participated in the 2013 *Governance for Quality* workshops hosted by the Canadian Patient Safety Institute (CPSI), you can still send representatives. We ask that new members or those who did not attend last year are prioritized in registration.

8. I'm not an AFHTO member; can I still come to a workshop?

These workshops are offered free of charge to AFHTO members and due to size restrictions of the workshops registration is strictly limited to members. If your organization is not currently an AFHTO member, please contact Saleemeh Abdolzahraei at <u>info@afhto.ca</u> to inquire about membership.

9. I'm not a board member, executive director or clinical lead. Can I still attend a workshop?

The *Effective Governance for Quality in Primary Care* program is tailored specifically to Board Members, Executive Directors and Clinical Leads. As such, other employees and stakeholders would not experience the full value of these workshops. For this reason, registration is open only to those who fulfil these roles.



10. Can I register more than one person at the same time?

Yes, after you've submitted registration for the first attendee, you will see the option 'Register Another Person'. If you click on it, you will be brought back to the beginning of the website to register a new person.

It is recommended that each organization send more than one person to the program to fully benefit from the training. There is a limit of 3 representatives from each member organization.

11. How do I confirm that I am registered for the workshop?

Once you register for the workshop you will receive an email confirmation. If you do not receive a confirmation within 24 hours please contact MCI Canada at <u>afhtoreg@mci-group.com</u>.

12. How do I make a change to my registration?

In your email confirmation there will be an **EDIT/CHANGE REGISTRATION** link. Click on the link and continue through the page.

13. When is the registration deadline?

Registration for individual workshops closes at 5:00 p.m. a week and a half before each workshop, as follows:

Ottawa: February 21, 2014 Toronto: March 12, 2014 Thunder Bay: March 19, 2014

14. The workshop I'd like to attend is full. What are my options?

If there is no longer any space available at the workshop you wanted to attend, we invite you to consider the other two sessions. If they're also full or you're not able to attend those sessions, you can submit your name to MCI Canada at <u>afhtoreg@mci-group.com</u> to be placed on a waiting list. Please be sure to indicate which session you'd like to attend.

15. What if I can no longer attend?

If you are not able to attend a workshop, please let us know as soon as you are able to do so. Once sessions fill up, we will open a waiting list for those interested in attending and we'll need to notify those on that list that space is available. All cancellations must be submitted in writing to MCI Canada at <u>afhtoreg@mci-group.com</u>.
