- Query is a complimentary tool to the HQO MyPracticeReport
- MPR not patient specific, time lag
- MPR provides snapshot, AP query drills down
- Local, private, immediate data in the hands of the practice team helps teams feel more comfortable about looking at opioid prescribing practices



Front-end queries, multiple EMRs

- Queries designed for use by individual practice teams and/or large-scale programs (Enables physicians to review their own patients in their own practice)
- Queries are developed using the front-end tools available within the native EMR settings
- No additional software or programming required
- Development plan for Telus PS, Accuro, OSCAR







 - Opioid MEQ for OSCAR released December 2017
- Query shared with Ontario MD Practice Enhancement Consultants who provide support to primary care practices
- HQO references query in November PCPR and Partnered Supports for Helping Patients Manage Pain
- Query shared with OCFP
- Query shared with Centre for Effective Practice (CEP) to be used in two CEP projects
- We have receive 42 requests for the query to date— 9 of those related to the release of the Physician PCPR on November 30, 2017



Opioid query spread - continued

- Successfully lobbied Accuro to make an enhancement to their EMR to allow for the calculation morphine equivalents (MEQ)
- OntarioMD is using the OSCAR MEQ query as the basis for developing an OSCAR dashboard for Opioids
- Queries are being referenced by CAMH and used by teams to established a baseline as part of their MOHLTC funded Opioid DE implementation Project
- Queries shared with HQO QIP Specialist as a potential support resource for teams completing 2018 QIP
