What steps to take?

- Develop admission and discharge workflow in collaboration with hospital
- Engage your EMR vendor and Meditech vendor
- Define human resources
- Determine technology resources



Early data....

- In 2018 thus far
 - 28% of patients discharged who were contacted within 72 hours
 - 21% of patients readmitted within 30 days
 - 8 patients have been referred to pharmacist





- Challenges with extracting data from PSS search
 - On-going refining
- # visits vs # of patients
- Referral process currently based on when discharge Rx ≠ EMR
