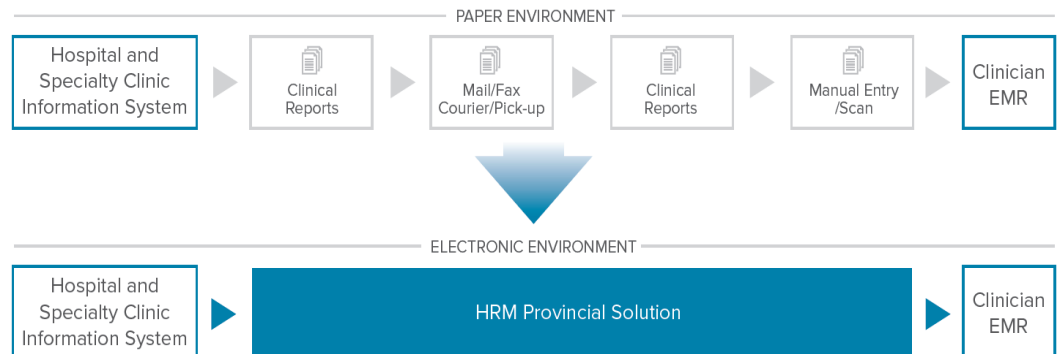


Benefits

Clinicians & Patients

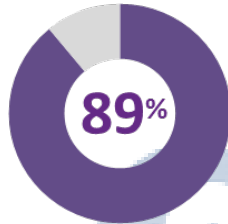
- Improves transition of patient care among care providers as providers are able to follow up with patients more quickly because reports are available sooner
- Text-based reports can be searchable and used to trend on report types per patient in the EMR
- Facilitates more informed clinical decision making¹ by supporting a comprehensive patient record in the EMR
- Expedites creation and communication of treatment plans¹ through the leveraged use of comprehensive record
- Reduces reliance on the primary provider (report recipient) as the entire clinical team has access to reports through the EMR¹
- Generates administrative and operational savings by reducing manual processes (e.g., scanning, saving files) associated with both paper and electronically faxed reports
- Reduces duplicate tests
- Enhances security of PHI in transmission and handling at the practice
- Enables regional integration

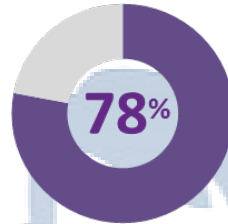

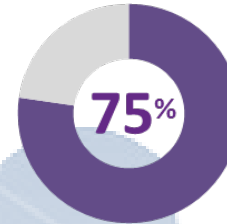

agree that **the timeliness of receiving reports** into their EMR has improved with HRM

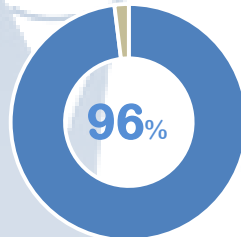


agree that **HRM functionality is easy to use**

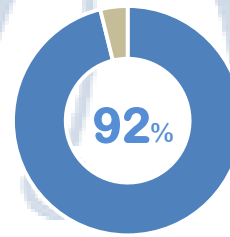


reported that **eNotifications allow for follow up with patients sooner** after their hospital visits.

POI



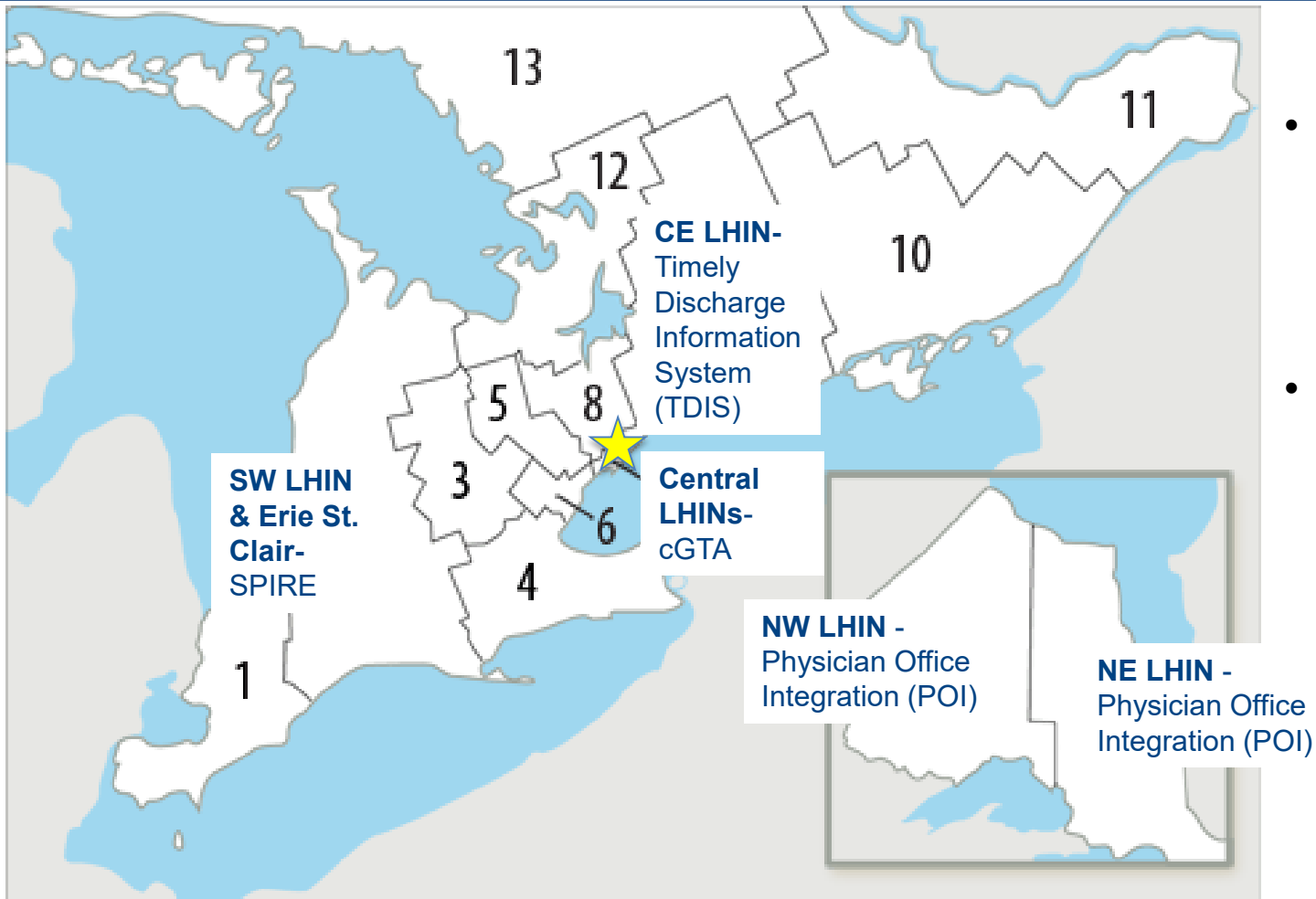
reported they were **moderately or very satisfied** with the **speed** of the POI reports



reported that the use of POI created **administrative efficiencies** for their organization



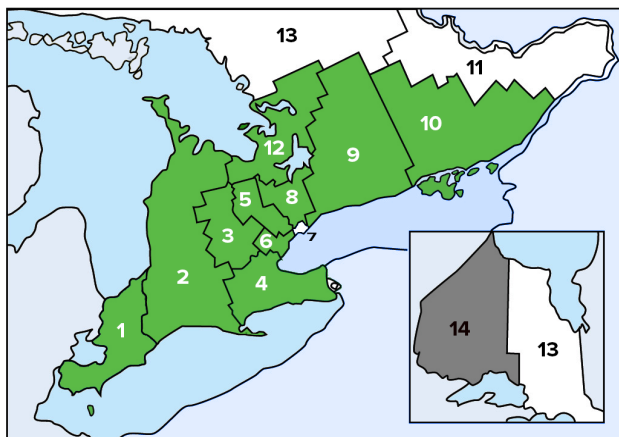
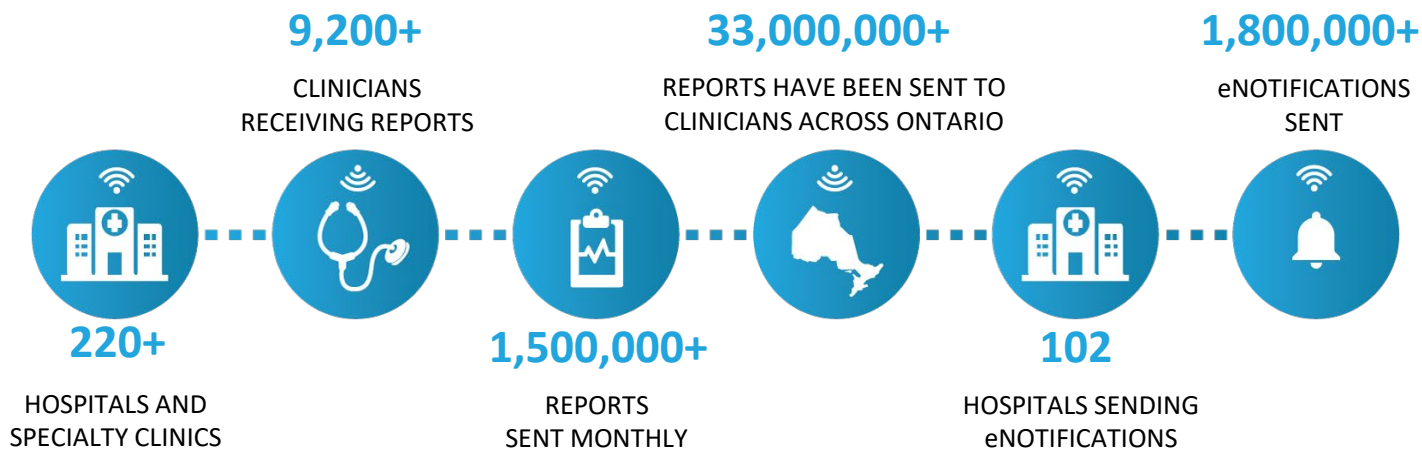
Historical Overview

- Allows data to be accessible to clinicians via the ClinicalViewer and Health Report Manager (HRM) solution

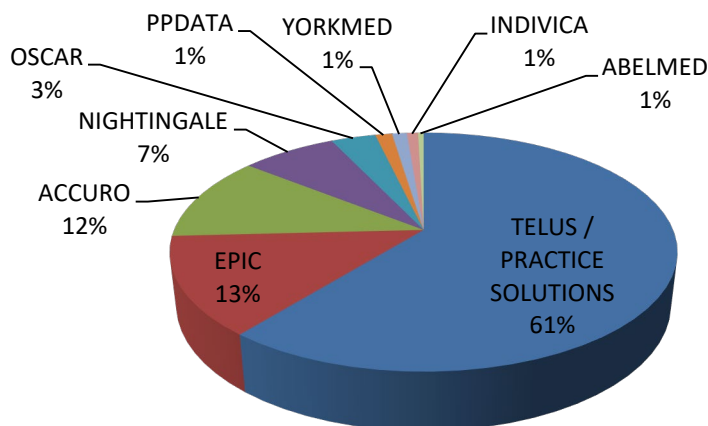

- 9,934,000+ reports sent to clinicians
- 220,000+ reports sent monthly

HRM/POI Key Differences

	HRM	POI
Sends Medical Records & Diagnostic Imaging reports (consult notes, discharge summaries, progress notes, procedure notes, etc.)		Transition to HRM (March 2019)
Report Types**	More Available	Limited
Sends Laboratory Results	Out of Scope	
Contributors	Province-wide* Specialty clinics, IHFs, hospitals	Limited to NE LHIN Specialty clinics, IHFs, hospitals
eNotification		Out of Scope

*HRM allows you to receive patient reports from hospitals and IHFs across Ontario

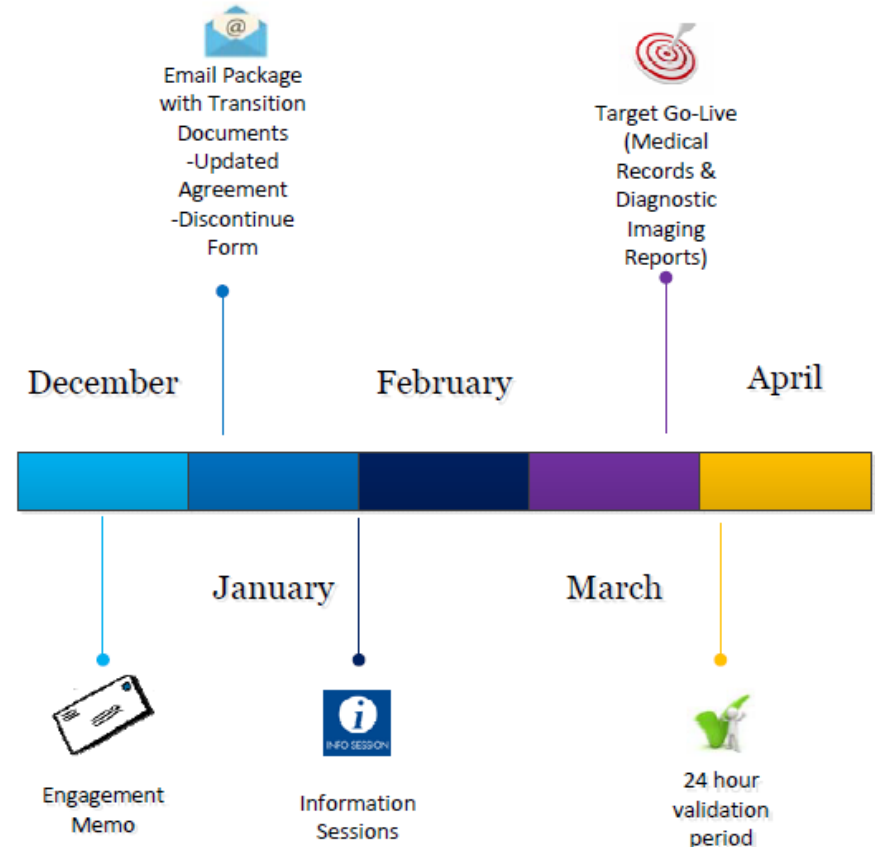
**HRM will deliver more report types from NE hospitals and IHFs (i.e. Mental Health, Respiratory Therapy, Electrodiagnostic reports). Exclusions vary by sending facility.

POI to HRM Transition

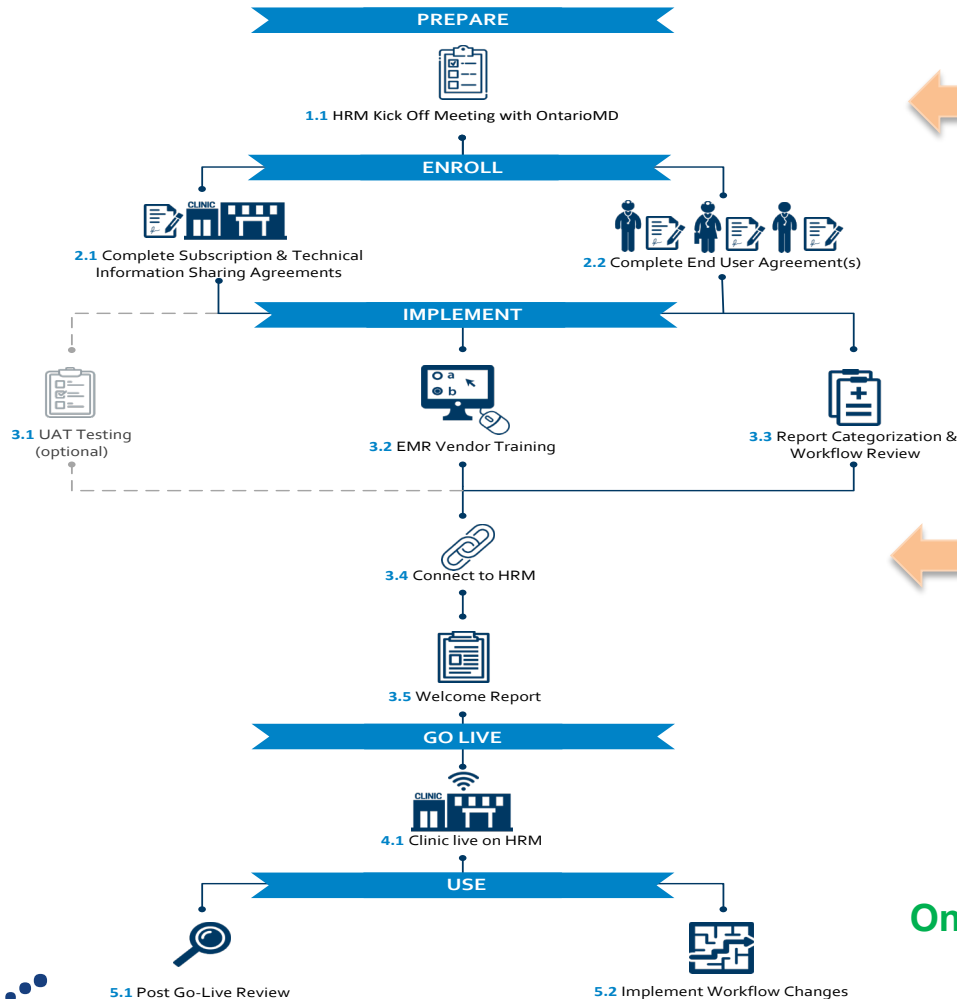
- Clinicians must have **BOTH** services running to receive all reports
 - **HRM** – MR & DI reports
 - **POI** – Lab & Non-HRM Contributors reports (North Bay, Sault, West Parry Sound)

Transition Requirements

- Clinics/Offices must transition all providers/nurse practitioners at the same time
- Updated POI Provider Agreement signed by each provider
- 24 hour validation period
- Send request to *POI Operations* team to stop duplicates/MR & DI report delivery via POI

HRM Onboarding Process

For Connectivity:

- OntarioMD will provide a deployment package and passkey to your technical contact, to share with your EMR vendor.
- EMR vendor will install security key and set-up your EMR for HRM.
- EMR vendor will inform OntarioMD to schedule a go-live for your clinic.

Onboarding time: approx. 1 week for ASP EMRs and 2-3 weeks for Local Server EMRs



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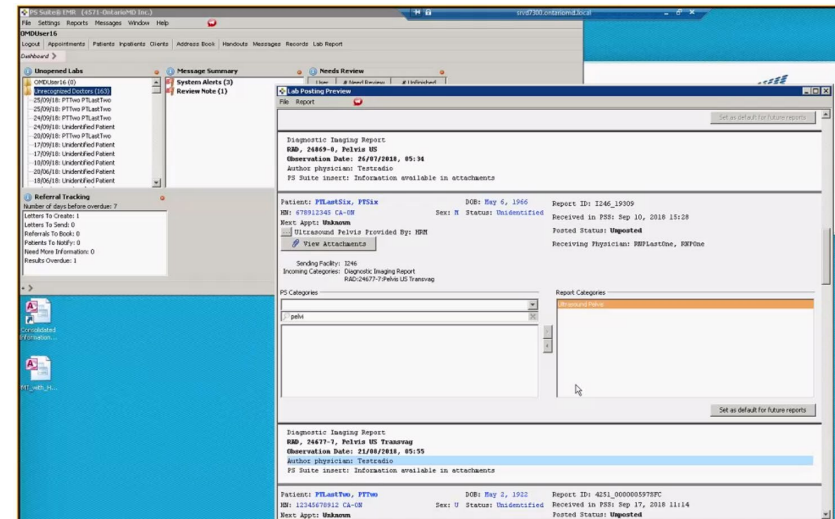
Using HRM

HRM User Training and Guidance:

- Where do you find reports received through HRM?
- How do you view reports?
- How do you mark reports as reviewed?
- How do you mark reports as approved?
- Where are reports stored?
- Report matching errors (i.e. you received a report not meant for you, handling unmatched patient reports)
- Report categorization
- Stopping paper/fax report delivery from hospitals / IHFs

HRM fits into your EMR workflow and will not disrupt your current POI report delivery

Types of Service Requests handled

Communication from Clinic



Reporting Request

Examples

- Total number of reports sent/ received
- Audit Log about recent HRM activity



Operational Request

Examples

Address Change, Name Change, Deactivations, EMR Vendor Change, Adding/ Removing a physician



Troubleshooting

Examples

Not receiving reports, Clinician not downloading reports, Non-Static IP, Missing data field within HRM Report, Mislabeled reports, Retiring physicians, License revoked etc.
