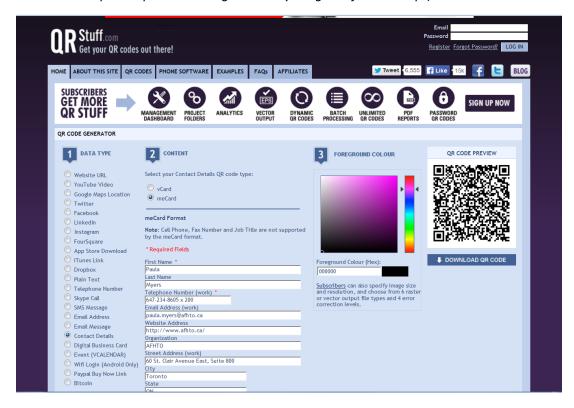
Instructions to generate QR codes

Conference attendees have expressed a desire to follow up with poster and concurrent session presenters – to ask questions, learn more about programs, etc. It's been suggested presenters can facilitate this by adding QR (i.e. Quick Response) codes to their presentations in lieu of or in addition to business cards and handouts. Attendees can then use their cell phones to capture all the relevant information they need. Below are instructions on how to generate a QR code online at no cost.

- 1) Go to http://www.grstuff.com/.
- 2) Pick the details you'd like to share e.g. contact details
- 3) Enter your information online. (*Tip if inputting contact details, pick type 'meCard' if you'd like to keep it simple. You can ignore everything else for this step.*)



- Pick your foreground colour (this will decide the predominant colour in your code).
- Pick your output type. Since this will be inserted in a poster or presentation slide, download or email are the preferred options.
