## Accessing RAAM Through SHC

#### Low Barrier

- Open to anyone who needs help
- OHIP

#### Client -Centered

- Collaborative
- Support by Clinician
- Referral to services
- No time limit

#### Walk-in

- No referral or appointment required
- Monday-Friday
- Case-by-case basis

## How Does RAAM Work?

#### Referral

- ED
- Hospital inpatient ward
- Withdrawal mgt services
- Primary care

#### Assessment

- Substance Use History
- Why Treatment?
- Goals?

#### Therapy

- Psychotherapy
- Pharmacotherapy

## How Does RAAM Work? (Cont'd)

#### Maintenance

- Patient can use RAAM for as long as needed
- Connect to other services
- Achieve Tx Goals

#### Stability

- Transfer back to PC provider
- Oversee Rx / Mgmt.
- Or provided w/ PC

#### Follow-up:

- Ongoing support
- Phone calls
- Emails
- Reassessment (if needed)



- O Connection!


#### Who Can Access the OPS?

### Model of Service






## Cycle of Relapse / Recidivism


