What is expected of me?

You will be contacted by your case manager, Hala Elimam, on your first day at home. Please call her if you go home earlier or have not heard from her within 24 hours of going home.

You may also receive equipment that will help



monitor your health condition at home such as a blood pressure cuff, weight scale or a blood sugar monitor.

Is there a cost?

No. Your OHIP covers the cost of your care.

What if I'm not a patient of the Family Health Team?

You will be offered to be linked to a family physician within the Family Health Team who will become your primary care physician.

Are you nervous to go home after being in the hospital?

Would you feel better going home if you knew someone would be contacting you to monitor your health?

Often when people are sent home from hospital, they are uneasy about how they will manage or are afraid they won't know what to do if they have questions.

What is a Virtual Ward?

Virtual wards use similar routines of a hospital ward to provide care to patients but without the walls of the hospital.



Patients sent home from hospital will receive follow-up care from various health care

providers by phone and home visit as necessary. This may include phone calls to monitor your daily symptoms, answering your questions about your medications and ensuring you have the supports to manage.

The benefits are that you will continue to receive close monitoring even when you are at home for up to 3 months.

It has been shown that those who have a network of family and health care providers are likely to have better outcomes.



The South East Toronto Family Health
Team's Virtual Ward Program provides
that support for you once you are sent
home from hospital. You will be followed
by your health care team including your
physician and physician assistant, Hala
Elimam, who will be calling you regularly to
ensure you are managing at home.
