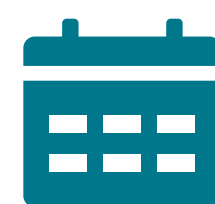
Participate in online learning and a research study

Provide safer, more inclusive care for sexually transmitted and blood-borne infections (STBBI)

The Canadian Public Health Association (CPHA) and its collaborators have developed an online course designed to support family physicians and other clinical care providers to increase their comfort in discussing sexuality, substance use and sexually transmitted and blood-borne infections (STBBI) and to create more welcoming and inclusive service environments. **We are seeking medicine, nursing and social work students in Canada to complete the four-hour online course and participate in evaluation surveys and a focus group.** This study has been approved by a University of Toronto Research Ethics Board (protocol # 00046315).

What to expect

If eligible, you will be invited to complete the online course (~4 hrs), a pre and post course survey (~20 min), and a three month follow up survey (~10 min). **Participants will be entered in a draw to win one of four \$100 VISA giftcards at each stage.**

You may be assigned to a control group, meaning that you will be invited to complete all surveys before being provided access to the course at the study conclusion (June 2025).

Some participants will additionally be invited to participate in a 90-minute virtual focus group (\$50 compensation).

Participation is voluntary, confidential and will in no way impact your academic standing.
