Accessing Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and Other Critical Supplies including Rapid Antigen Tests (RATs)

Ensuring that primary care providers have sufficient PPE and other critical supplies and equipment (CSE), including rapid antigen tests, is a critical component in supporting our health care system.

What is happening?

Primary care providers are transitioning to a new integrated order management system – the <u>PPE Supply Portal (PSP)</u> – a simple, self-serve, online tool, available 24/7 for ordering PPE and CSE from the government's stockpile.

Who is affected?

All primary care providers, in Ontario, who currently use Remedy to order PPE, CSE, and RATs supplies from the government's stockpile.

What do I need to do?

Follow these easy steps to register for a PSP account before February 28, 2023:

- Complete the online PPE Supply Portal registration form to register for an account, before February 28, 2023.
- Check your inbox for an email that an online PPE Supply Portal account has been created for you (please note this may take a few days to arrive, while your form is reviewed).
- Follow the link provided in the email. Please select "Forgot Password" and follow the prompts to reset the password and activate the account.
- Review the User Guide and Quick Reference guide attached to the account creation email you receive for further details about using the PSP.
