

## 12. Comments:

### Response text:

- 1** I would like to have more interaction with other FHTs, both existing and Wave 5 (like us) to ask questions, get advice, compare how we are doing, etc. I would like these FHT to be small and rural like we are too.
- 2** I would enjoy more contact with other FHT's. I feel that the information and support that can be obtained through other teams is invaluable. This is why I enjoy the AFHTO workshops so much. It is really my only opportunity to network with other teams. I do periodically contact other teams if I am looking for specific information.
- 3** I developed a conference for my LHINS administrators and have included ED's of the CHC's and other groups within my LHIN. It has been attended both years by MOHLTC and this year by the LHIN speakers included CCAC, CDA and others.
- 4** I meet with other FHTs as needed and ask question to FHTs as needed. Formalized structures for group meetings are inefficient and would be a waste of time.
- 5** I used to be a part of the FHT Administrators group which was discontinued.
- 6** This is a wave 5 FHT so there has been limited interaction to date but we are being included in the TC LHIN admin lead group to start regular meetings in Feb. 2011.
- 7** Priority strategy for AFHTO should be negotiating with HOOP and lobbying the Ministry to bring salaries on par with other organizations - especially for NPs and RNS.
- 8** I would love to have more interaction with other medical leads. Even a single other physician lead would be good for sharing of ideas and resources.
- 9** Seems that we keep building more and more administration. Soon we will have no time to see patients anymore.
- 10** We only just created a Facebook account for our FHT, so haven't had a chance to use it much. The plan is to create a private group page for a 12-week weight loss program we're starting in March; otherwise I don't think we'll be using it much.
- 11** We were granted a FHT in WAVE 5 and except for our initial discussions with Elliot Lake FHT and Guelph FHT re: organization we have not had another discussion. At that time, discussions took place between physicians and administrative leads. We hope to talk to other FHTS thru QIIP meetings and participation in Strategic Planning workshops.
- 12** I would be willing to contribute to your cause.
- 13** We are a wave 5 FHT and just getting started - would love to be more involved and connected with AFHTO.
- 14** It is really great to see AFHTO supporting us and moving us ahead.
- 15** Admin staff have been invited to a few functions; invited by the HFHT, there have been other good intentions to get together more in the LIHN but not brought to fruition as yet.
- 16** The 9 FHTs in Huron Perth meet monthly and then we e-mail each other.
- 17** I co-chair a northeast group of all the northern FHT 21 of us which we conference/OTN every second month. I also represent the NE group with our PAN northern committee made up of NE and NW FHT reps.
- 18** Our FHT is still in development. Communications as a group will likely develop at a later date.
