## IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF CARE

The primary care sector is at the centre of transformational change in Ontario. To provide a common, evidence-based platform of governance training to support the quality agenda in the primary care sector, the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC) supports the delivery of the **Effective Governance for Quality and Patient Safety** learning sessions in 2013. This governance training will not only enhance current governance skills within primary care models, but it will provide boards with an understanding of their role to support the development of Quality Improvement Plans (QIP), and in turn, support implementation of the newly forming Health Links.

### COME AND UNDERSTAND A BOARD'S CORE FUNCTION RELATED TO QUALITY

As a board member it is your responsibility to recognize how a culture of quality within an organization can be led, supported and sustained. This day long workshop will help you identify approaches to measure quality of care. You will also have the opportunity to identify tools, structures and processes to assist in improving your organization's governance oversight of quality.

### WHO SHOULD PARTICIPATE

This initiative is designed for the organization's board members and senior management (executive directors, clinical leads). It is recommended that each organization send three participants including: the board chair, chair of the board quality committee (or other board representatives) and the executive director or clinical lead.
